Position Summary

Perform tasks involving driving to various excavation sites to assure compliance with New York State Code Rule 753 regarding the protection of underground facilities.

Essential Functions

The essential functions include, but are not limited to the following:

- Safely drive to various excavation locations.
- Assure compliance with all regulation of the New York State Code Rule 753 regarding the protection of underground facilities.
- Comply with good safety practices at excavation sites.
- Promote safe excavation practices via conversation with excavators.
- Report all excavation site visits on the iPad Mini device (provided).
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications (Incl. Knowledge, Skills and Abilities)

- Must have a valid New York State (NYS) driver's license and clear Dept. of Motor Vehicle (DMV) record (1)
- Must have a personal vehicle (even if driving Company provided vehicle)
- If driving a personal vehicle, vehicle must be in good working condition, have valid and current NYS inspection record, reliable, use UL regular gas, and have reasonable gas mileage performance
- If driving Company vehicle, must be responsible for basic upkeep (e.g., cleanliness)
- Willing to provide written consent for GPS tracking of location (via Company issued cell phone, tablet/laptop, Company issued vehicle, or personal vehicle)
- Willing to travel outside assigned territory when needed.
- Working cellular phone with voice and camera/video capability
- Willingness and ability to perform verbal and written instructions.

- Ability to understand, follow and transmit written and oral instructions over various communication methods.
- Ability to organize and prioritize daily work.

- Ability to meet attendance schedule with dependability and consistency.
- Ability to understand and communicate Code Rule 753
- Validated by physical review of actual license which will be photocopied and put on file with Company.

Physical Demands and Work Environment

The employee regularly works near and inside excavation areas and in outside conditions that include inclement weather, heat and humidity.

While performing the duties of this position, the employee is regularly required to talk or hear. The employee frequently is required to use hands to operate or feel objects, tools or controls, is required to stand, walk, climb and balance. Specific vision abilities required by this position include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, and the ability to adjust focus.
